## **Major Requirements**

Students majoring in Sociology are required to elect a minimum of 33 credits in the field, including Sociology Core courses: SOC 1010, 2200, 3200, 3220, 3050, 4010, 4996. Oakland Community College does not offer all of these core courses, but it does offer the following:
