

WSU strongly recommend that all transfer students fulfill their general education requirements through the <u>Michigan</u> <u>Transfer Agreement (MTA)</u> before transferring to WSU. Each community college has an MTA approved course list of its own, so please refer to the list of courses that your respective community college has approved for MTA.
